Jill Blevins, American Heart Association and FOL Board, is always reading a variety of selections including:

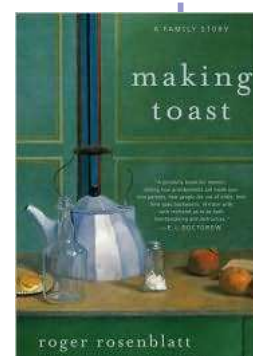
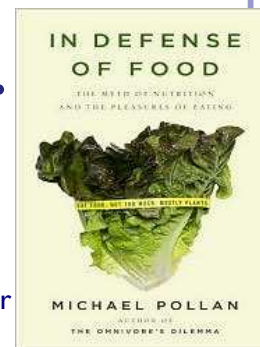
***In Defense of Food*, Michael Pollan**
