Reader’s Corner: What Your Friends are Reading...

Betty Bettachi, *Past President, Friends of the Library Board*

Betty has recently finished reading the **Millennium Trilogy Series** by Stieg Larsson.

The Millennium Trilogy Series is comprised of *The Girl with the Dragon Tattoo*, *The Girl Who Played with Fire* and *The Girl Who Kicked the Hornet’s Nest*. All three novels have been made into films. They are murder mysteries with an eccentric heroine—an angry, pierced and tattooed punk named Lisbeth Salander, who also happens to be a computer genius. Of the three books, the first one is Betty’s favorite.

In addition to the captivating novels,

the author’s life is an interesting story in itself. Larsson delivered manuscripts for all three novels to his publisher at one time. Larsson lived in Sweden and was the editor-in-chief of the magazine *Expo* and a leading expert on antidemocratic right-wing extremist and Nazi organizations. The lead male character in the first book shares a similar career to Larsson and encounters a few characters who served the Nazi party in earlier years.

Larsson died in 2004 at age 50, shortly after delivering the manuscripts.
