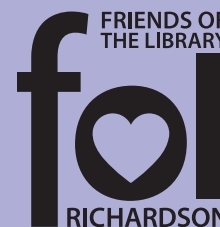

FOL Board Secretary Sandy Martin is in the midst of the following selections:

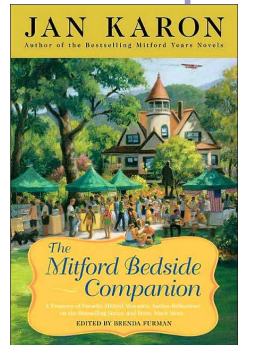
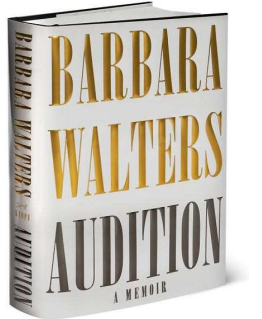
The Mitford Bedside Companion, Jan Karon
